Not only did Chris design the fliers but he has paid to have the printing of 4,000 election fliers and 12,000 Positive Money NZ fliers done – as well as sending them down to Wellington by courier. If that is not enough, Chris's Mum has agreed to do our first leaflet drop in Auckland – distributing 1,000 fliers. Chris's Mum was the first person to subscribe to our newsletter – and is on this distribution list – so thank you very much to them both.

If the Foxton crowd would like 1,000 positive Money fliers let me know and I will send them up.

On Saturday the 5th, Sue and I went to the Newtown Farmers Market and handed out 200 election fliers.

We then went to the “Occupy the Terrace” event which was not well attended. There would have been about 15 of us there but Sue was great. She set herself up at the traffic lights with one of our vertical banners and passed Positive Money fliers through the windows of cars stopped at the lights.

On Sunday the 6th we distributed another 400 fliers in and around Newtown and we also attached 30 laminated election posters to lamp posts throughout the electorate. I then set to work scheduling myself in for meet the candidate events.

On Tuesday the 8th I attended the first candidates meeting and [the Dom Post newspaper article](#) had a great photo of me – except for my head – which was obscured by the lectern. I had only three minutes [for my speech](#) - but I did enjoy myself.

I have further speaking events tomorrow at 7pm in Newtown at St Annes Church Hall in Emmet St – Saturday the 12th at 2pm the Kilbirnie Community Sports Centre - Sunday the 13th 2pm at the Sea Scouts room at Cog Park and finally Wednesday the 23rd 7:30 pm at the Island Bay Baptist church.

The other big event is the screening of [“The Secret of Oz”](#) at the Paramount Theatre on Thursday the 17th November at 6:30pm. (Running time 101 minutes plus question and answer time.) Tickets cost \$15.00. Bookings at the theatre. We would love to see you there.
