**Thursday the 10<sup>th</sup>** I spoke at well attended candidate meetings in [Newtown \(Thursday\)](#) where there were about 250 present [and Kilbirnie \(Saturday the 12th\)](#) where there were about 200.

**Friday the 11<sup>th</sup>** Our election fliers arrived (4,000) together with 7,000 positive money ones.

**Saturday the 12<sup>th</sup>** Sue and I were at the Newtown Farmers Market on Saturday morning handing out fliers and we meet some of the people who had attended the Newtown meeting. One person said that I had her vote on the strength of my talk. One down and 9,900 to go.

**Sunday the 13<sup>th</sup>** The meeting at Haitaitai was less well attended – with about 50 people there – but we did get good feedback on the Raf Manji interview. Numbers were not helped by the event clashing with the Santa parade.

Sue and I are very happy with the profile we are getting – and the interview with Raf was a real bonus.

Also as I am standing against Chris Finlayson, a current Cabinet minister, Annette King, Deputy leader of the Labour party and Russel Norman – Co leader of the Green party so they are getting to hear about the banking system as well.

My last candidates meeting will be on the 23<sup>rd</sup> at the Island Bay Baptist church at 7:30.
